■ THE 10 SHIFTS

What changed in 2026.

01 AI screening is now table-stakes

78% of mid-to-large companies route every resume through an ATS scoring layer first. ATS-friendly formatting and keyword density are no longer optional — they are the first 30 seconds of the review.

02 The bullet point is dying

Recruiters scan in F-pattern for ~6 seconds. Quantified outcomes in the first 1-2 bullets per role drive 3.4x more responses than feature-listy bullets. Lead with impact, not duty.

03 One-page is back

For <8 YoE candidates, one-page resumes get 22% more callbacks. Two pages only beats one when you have measurable scope to fill them — not when you pad.

04 Skills sections are the new keyword bank

ATS keyword matching weighted the Skills section 1.8x heavier than Experience prose in 2025. Cluster skills by domain (Languages, Frameworks, Cloud, Tools) — not a flat alphabetical list.

05 LinkedIn parity matters more than ever

61% of recruiters compare your resume to your LinkedIn within 30 seconds. Title mismatches and date gaps tank your trust score. Mirror your headline and last 3 roles exactly.

06 Custom GPTs and AI co-pilots are visible

Listing AI tools as 'Used ChatGPT' is a yellow flag. Listing them as 'Shipped 4 internal Copilot agents' is a hire signal. Recruiters now distinguish between consumers and builders.

07 Remote-first is normalizing

Listing your timezone (e.g. 'EAT / UTC+3') plus 'Async-fluent' improves remote-role response rates by 19% vs. omitting either.

08 Cover letters split into two camps

Short (<150 word) intro emails outperform full one-page cover letters at startups by 2.1x. Enterprise still prefers the full letter. Match the company size to the letter format.

09 Stack-specific resumes win

One resume tailored to ONE stack (e.g. 'Next.js + Supabase + Vercel' across summary, skills, and 2 most relevant bullets) beats a generic full-stack resume 4:1 on response rate.

10 Recency beats prestige

A 2024-2025 internal hackathon win is worth more than a 2018 FAANG line in 2026. Recruiters discount roles older than 5 years aggressively for IC engineering positions.
